9 Days MOROCCO: Imperial Cities

(Departs Every Saturday - min. 2 Adults)

Day 1 Depart for Morocco (Saturday) Meals on Board, Dinner

Your trip to Morocco begins with a pleasant flight to Casablanca onboard Emirates, the award-winning airline. On arrival, transfer to hotel and check-in. Dinner and overnight stay in Casablanca.

Day 2 Casablanca-Rabat [95 km] (Sunday) B, L, D

After breakfast, proceed for a tour of Casablanca - the economic capital of Morocco. You will visit the central market, the Habous district, the Royal Palace, Mohamed V Square, Anfa's residential quarter and the imposing Hassan II Mosque (and its interior), the largest mosque in the world after the Grand Mosque of Makkah. Lunch at one of the seafront restaurants. Thereafter depart for Rabat, the capital of Morocco. A city tour follows, visiting the Royal Palace, the Oudaya Kasbah, mausoleum of King Mohamed V and the historic Hassan Tower. Overnight stay in Rabat.

Day 3 Rabat-Meknes-Fez [220 km] (Monday) B, L, D

After breakfast, travel to Fez via Volubilis, the Roman capital of north-western Africa. Enroute, a stopover in Meknes, the Ismailian capital famous for its 40 km walls. You will visit the monumental Bab Al Mansour Gate, the Royal stables and the Jewish quarter. After lunch, proceed to Fez via the holy city of Moulay Idriss and the ruins of the Roman city of Volubilis. Dinner and overnight stay in Fez.

Day 4 Fez (Tuesday) B, L, D

Today, enjoy a full day sightseeing in Fez, the cultural and spiritual centre of Morocco. The whole old city of Fez, the oldest of the Imperial cities, has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Your tour includes the Medina (Old City) with its exquisite Medersa Bou Inania, the beautiful fountain of Nejjarine Square, the Mausoleum of Moulay Idris II and the Karaouine mosque. Lunch at a traditional restaurant in the Medina. Thereafter, tour the walled Fez el-Jedid or the "New Fez", where the Museum of Moroccan Arts is located. Dinner and overnight stay in Fez.

Day 5 Fez-Beni Mellal-Marrakesh [485 km] (Wednesday) B, L, D

Depart for Marrakesh, passing by the charming Berber village of Immouzer du Kandjar and Ifrane. Lunch in Beni Mellal, known as the "gateway to the south".

Arrive in Marrakesh in late afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay in Marrakesh.

Day 6 Marrakesh (Thursday) B, L, D

There is much to see in this fascinating city. Tour the Menara pavilion and gardens, the stately Koutoubia Minaret, the hidden tombs of the Saadian dynasty, Bahia Palace and Majorelle Gardens, named after a famous French painter. In 1980 it became the residence of Yves Saint Laurent. In the afternoon, during the tour of the souk (market), you will see some age-old guild artisans at work. Finally, immerse in the carnival-like atmosphere of the famous Djemaa el-Fna Square which is crowded with acrobats, jugglers, story-tellers and snake charmers. Moroccan tea is served at the "Maison de la photographie", a riad in the old town where clients can admire an amazing photo collection of "Landscapes and Faces of Morocco" taken between 1870 and 1950.

In the evening, enjoy Dinner whilst watching the exciting Fantasia show depicting Berber horsemen in tightly choreographed horse-riding stunts and rifle-firing.

Day 7 Marrakesh-Casablanca [250 km] (Friday) B, L, D

Morning, free at leisure. Lunch at a local restaurant. Then depart for Casablanca. Dinner and overnight stay in Casablanca.

Day 8 Casablanca-Singapore (Saturday) B, Meals on Board

Bid farewell to Morocco! After breakfast, transfer to airport for return flight to Singapore.

Day 9 Singapore (Sunday) Meals on Board

Arrival in Singapore with fond memories and wonderful souvenirs from Morocco!!
